The exhibit of more than 100 prints includes photographs from all phases of Weston’s five decade career, from his first nude in 1909 to his famous studies of green peppers and other natural forms.

### **Black Light Photography Program on March 17th**

Some of you may remember the black light craze of the 1960’s, Jimi Hendrix posters and all that stuff. However, black light also has some interesting applications for photographers. To take photos under black light, all that you’ll need are an inexpensive black light fixture, some objects that react to black light and (preferably) a tripod since exposures tend to be very long.
